#### **Indicator**

### **BFA Portfolio Review**

Students in the BFA Graphic Design program will be required to take ARTS 3322, Typography. At the conclusion of this course, students will submit a portfolio for review and admission into upper level courses in the BFA program. The portfolio will demonstrate

- an understanding of typographic standards
- the ability to select type appropriate for a given project
- the ability to organize typographic information in a logical, hierarchal manner
- the ability to use type as image
- the ability to employ type as an expressive visual element

Graphic design faculty will evaluate work in the portfolios.

#### Rubric:

- 10 = Student demonstrates perfection in ability
- 9 = Student demonstrates exceptional expertise
- 8 = Student demonstrates proficiency and skillfulness
- 7=Student demonstrates adequate ability
- 6 = Student demonstrates ability that needs improvement to be adequate
- 5= Student demonstrates that there is no ability or grasp of the concept or technique
- 0= Student fails to demonstrate anything
