Objective:

Students will exhibit a cohesive body of work.

Criteria:

The work will demonstrate:

- The ability to express a concept through the artwork
- Artistic development and growth through the evolution of a concept
- the possibility of further development (concept is not closed, eg the Four Seasons)
- appropriate choice of materials to express concept
- evidence of the artist's personal voice
- professional presentation

The work in the Senior Exhibition will be evaluated by members of the studio art and photography faculty.

Please evaluate the work in senior student exhibitions.

Rubric:

100 = Student demonstrates perfection in ability

90 = Student demonstrates exceptional expertise

80 = Student demonstrates proficiency and skillfulness

70 = Student demonstrates adequate ability

60 = Student demonstrates ability that needs improvement to be adequate

50 = Student demonstrates that there is no ability or grasp of the concept or technique

0 = Student fails to demonstrate anything
