

WILL MY CREDITS TRANSFER?

Sam Houston State University accepts 66 academic hours plus four kinesiology hours for a total of 70 credit hours from community colleges. All academic courses attempted at a four-year regionally accredited U.S. university will be reviewed for transferability. Transferable courses may not be relevant to every degree plan. **shsu.edu/prospects/transfer**

Once accepted, students should schedule an advising appointment with the Student Advising and Mentoring (SAM) Center and also register to attend the Transfer Orientation. **shsu.edu/advising** and **shsu.edu/orientation/transfer**

In addition to advising, SHSU offers student support services such as the reading and writing centers, study skills support, and strong mentoring programs. Our goal is to help you all the way through to graduation!

TRANSFER STUDENTS

APPLY:

- 1. Complete an online application for admission with a nonrefundable \$45 application fee. **applytexas.org**
- 2. Submit official transcripts on all previous coursework from ALL colleges or universities attended.

REQUIREMENTS:

0-11 hours	must meet beginning freshman
	requirements and have a minimum
	2.5 gpa on transferable hours
12-17 hours	must have a minimum 2.5 gpa
	on transferable hours
18+ hours	must have a minimum 2.0 gpa
	on transferable hours

Eligible transfer students must not be on suspension from any other college or university. Coursework must be transferable college level semester hours.

BEARKAT TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

Bearkat Transfer Scholarships will automatically be offered to students who meet the conditions listed below. No application is required other than applying for admission to Sam Houston State University. Awards will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Transfer Scholarship Conditions:

- 1. First-time SHSU student,
- 2. Transfer from an accredited community college or university,
- 3. Be an undergraduate student, seeking their first bachelors degree,
- 4. Have a minimum of 45 transferable academic credit hours, and
- 5. Have a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.75.

PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP

Up to ten \$1000 scholarships are offered each year (\$500 awarded in Fall semester and \$500 awarded in Spring semester) to students and are determined on a competitive basis. Recipients must: have completed a minimum of 45 hours with a minimum 3.5 gpa at a junior or community college; be a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours per semester) while at SHSU; transfer directly from a community or junior college; be a Phi Theta Kappa member in good standing at the time of transfer; become an active member of the Beta of Texas Alumni Chapter at SHSU. The priority date is June 1 to submit the application and all transcripts (including transcript through the Spring semester). Complete online scholarship application portal. shsu.edu/scholarships
