TRANSFER STUDENTS

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Eligible transfer students must not be on suspension from any other college or university. Coursework must be transferable college level semester credit hours.
- 2. Sam Houston State University accepts a maximum of 66 academic hours plus four hours of activity-based physical education (kinesiology) for a total of 70 semester credit hours from the accredited community colleges attended.

0-11 hours	must meet beginning freshman requirements and have a minimum 2.5 gpa on transferable hours
12-17 hours	must have a minimum 2.5 gpa on transferable hours
18+ hours	must have a minimum 2.0 gpa on transferable hours
