The Higher Education Accountability System is used to track performance on critical measures that exemplify higher education institutions' missions. The System is modeled on the state's higher education plan, <u>Closing the Gaps by 2015</u>. Its major focus is on the four Closing the Gaps target areas of participation, success, excellence and research.

By 2015, close the gaps in participation rates across Texas to add 630,000 more students.
