Overview: There will be three main focuses in this course: 1) look at the overall field of Operating Systems; 2) explore the Unix/Linux operating system in more detail and 3) look at distributed and parallel computing and how they relate to operating system design.

There will be two during-semester exams and a final exam. Each exam will be worth 200 points. Except for extremely unusual circumstances, no make-up exams will be given.

There will be several programming and homework (non-programming) assignments. There may also be group projects, written assignments and presentations. These assignments will sum to 400 points. I will normally accept a late assignment up to one week late with a 20% late penalty.
