Effective Fall 2006, first time college/university students must satisfy the following requirements before being allowed to enroll in upper-division (300- and 400-level) business courses:

- Complete the following courses with at least a 2.0 GPA:
  - Accounting (ACC) 231 and 232 (ACCT 2401 and 2402)
    - Business Analysis (BAN) 232 (BUSI 2372)
    - Economics (ECO) 233 and 234 (ECON 2302 and 2301)
  - Math (MTH) 199 (MATH 1324)
- Complete at least 50 semester hours
- Earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 on all college level work attempted

A maximum of 66 credit hours (excluding kinesiology) may be transferred from a community college to Sam Houston St University. Students should carefully select courses to complete the associate degree while minimizing the number of hours that might exceed the 66 hour cap for transfer credit. Enrollment in ACC 365 (Intermediate Accounting) requires the completion of ACC 231 and ACC 232 with a minimum grade of C in each.
