The amount of funding the Office of Graduate Studies can provide the academic colleges is an indicator of success with respect to promoting knowledge of the literature and research among the students.
Criteria	Increase in funding for student travel An increase in funding from the Office of Graduate Studies will be indicative of continued and expanded support.
Finding	Funds Supporting Student Travel In the 2006-2007 academic year, the Office of Graduate Studies provided approximately \$74,500 to support student travel to present at professional meetings. This represented an increase of more than 60% compared to the funds provided in the 2005-2006 academic year.
