




 COE faculty produced <u>34%</u> of SHSU's publications and <u>38%</u> of SHSU's presentations in 2006-2007.


Teaching Scores by Indicator COE % Exceeding SHSU Mean





Change in Student Teaching Program 2003-2007








Student Teacher Performance SHSU Overall Teacher Work Sample Results






