Designation of Point Values Assigned to Rubric

- Excellent = 10 points per mark
- Very Good = 8 points per mark
- Adequate = 7 points per mark
- Fair = 6 points per mark
- Poor = 5 points per mark
- No Evidence = 0 points per mark

Categories: How Designation is Determine:

Number of “√” marks in each sections is counted, the total number of marks per section is multiplied times the factor designated per section of the Rubric.
 Example: 5 marks in Excellent = 5 x 10 = 50 points
 3 marks in Very Good = 3 x 8 = 24 points
 Total Points for Rubric = 100 points
