

2012 June Education Report Service Data
This report includes candidates tested from August 2007 - July 2012

NOTE: The table below contains self-report information on EPPP candidates who tested between August 2007 and July 2012. Only doctoral programs that are APA/CPA accredited or have met ASPPB/National Register Joint Designation criteria are listed individually by name in the table. Programs that lost their accreditation/designation status during the previous year will no longer be available for selection in the online application. All data for individual programs are shown when there are 10 or more graduates who tested from August 2007 to July 2012. When there are 5 to 9 candidates who tested, the exact number is not shown, but pass rates and content area data are shown. When there are 4 or fewer candidates who tested, neither the exact number nor the pass rates are shown. These omissions serve to protect the privacy of individual candidates. The data include all candidates who took the exam during that five-year period, not just first-time test takers. Therefore, if someone has taken the exam more than once during the period, the data for all of their administrations is included. The pass rates included in this table are based on the ASPPB recommended passing score of 500 for independent practice. Although each board sets the standard for passing, in its respective state or province, at the present time, the majority of jurisdictions using the EPPP accept the ASPPB recommended passing score for independent practice.
