Services we offer include:


- Workshops and seminars covering study skills, financial literacy, financial aid, graduate school, career skills, and more!

- · A spirit of community offering support and encouragement


Who does Project CONNECT help? We currently serve 165 highly-motivated first generation, low-income, and/or disabled students. All of our participants must display an academic need for our services.
