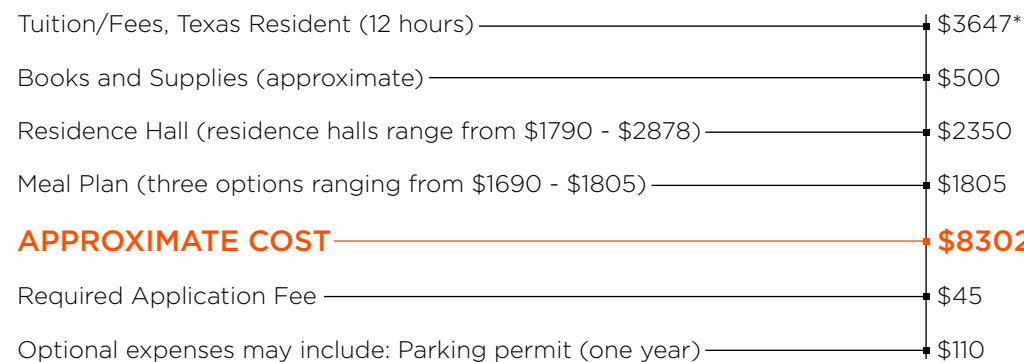

BEGINNING FRESHMAN STUDENTS

SUBMIT:

1. Completed online application for admission with a nonrefundable \$45 application fee. applytexas.org
2. Official ACT or SAT I scores required regardless of class rank.
3. Official high school transcript showing date of graduation and class rank.

REQUIREMENTS:

Eligible beginning freshman students must graduate from an accredited* high school, completing at least the recommended high school plan or meet the College Readiness Standards on the ACT or SAT.

Requirements for high school graduation plans are regulated by the state legislature and subject to change. Please visit our website for the most up-to-date information.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

SUBMIT:

1. Completed online application for admission with a nonrefundable \$45 application fee. applytexas.org
2. Official transcripts on all previous coursework from ALL colleges or universities attended.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Eligible transfer students must not be on suspension from any other college or university. Coursework must be transferable college level semester credit hours.
2. Sam Houston State University accepts a maximum of 66 academic hours plus four hours of activity-based physical education (kinesiology) for a total of 70 semester credit hours from the accredited community colleges attended.

0-11 hours	must meet beginning freshman requirements and have a minimum 2.5 gpa on transferable hours
12-17 hours	must have a minimum 2.5 gpa on transferable hours
18+ hours	must have a minimum 2.0 gpa on transferable hours
