STUDENT EXIT INTERVIEW FORM

3. How would you rate the quality of your assignments in your graduate courses? Do you feel that the assignments provided you with the adequate skills to pursue your career goals with a History MA?
4. Was there enough diversity in the course offerings to meet your academic interests and needs? Suggestions?
5. Did your courses utilize new or cutting edge technology that may be relevant to your academic interests and needs?
6. How would you rate your experience with the online learning management system at SHSU? Any specific problems?
7. What was the best part of your experience in the MA program?
8. What one thing would you change if you could to improve the MA program for future students?
9. What are your career plans? Are you considering further graduate work or a career in education, archival work, etc.?
