- UNIV 1301.77: Introduction to Collegiate Studies (CRN 82244)

Spring Courses

- Students must choose CRIJ 2362 and at least one other course from the list:
- CRIJ 2362.75: Criminology (CRN 23816)
 - HIST 1302.19: United States History Since 1876 (CRN 20853)
 - MUSC 2364.03: History of Rock, Jazz, and Popular Music (CRN 22525)
 - POLS 2305.05: American Government (CRN 20461)
 - PSYC 1301.03: Introduction to Psychology (CRN 20686)

In order to participate in the CJ LLC program, students must be accepted to SHSU, have a completed Housing Application and \$200 deposit on file, and fill out a separate CJ LLC application. In addition to the application, students must attach an essay.
