CUST	10/16/06	Cut on top of thumb	None	Employee was cleaning the paper towel dispenser in the 3 rd floor ladies restroom of the Smith-Hutson Business Building when the edge of the dispenser cut her thumb	None
CUST	01/05/07	Chemical burn on left foot	None	Employee was stripping floors of wax with other co-workers when stripper chemical was absorbed in her shoes causing a slight burn to her left foot. She was wearing tennis shoes at the time of the incident.	Co-Workers
CUST	05/07/07	Allergic reaction to latex gloves, both hands	None	Employee was using a different type of disposable glove than what she had been wearing. Towards the end of her shift, her hands started itching. She continued to work and upon removing the gloves, her hands and between her fingers had broken out with a very bad rash and blisters. The base of the thumb on her right hand was the worse with large blue discoloration and raw abrasions. Her hands also appeared swollen.	None
