 - The SACS Reaffirmation process is doable; organizing supporting documentation is the hardest part.

- 4. The committee continued a standard-by-standard review creating a list of supporting documentation. The committee completed standards 3.4.6 through 3.7.1 (excluding 3.4.10, 3.5.2).
- 5. A question was raised as to when the Faculty Handbook revisions will be completed. Dr. Eglsaer informed the committee that they hoped to have the Faculty Handbook revisions completed by Summer 2007.
- 6. It was pointed out that many universities already have some connections made between standards within their reports. It was suggested that members take a look at a couple of these institutions to get a start on compiling the matrix.
- 7. Next Meeting: Wednesday, January 24, 2007. At this meeting the committee will continue the review for supporting documentation and will look at standards that relate to or reference one another.
